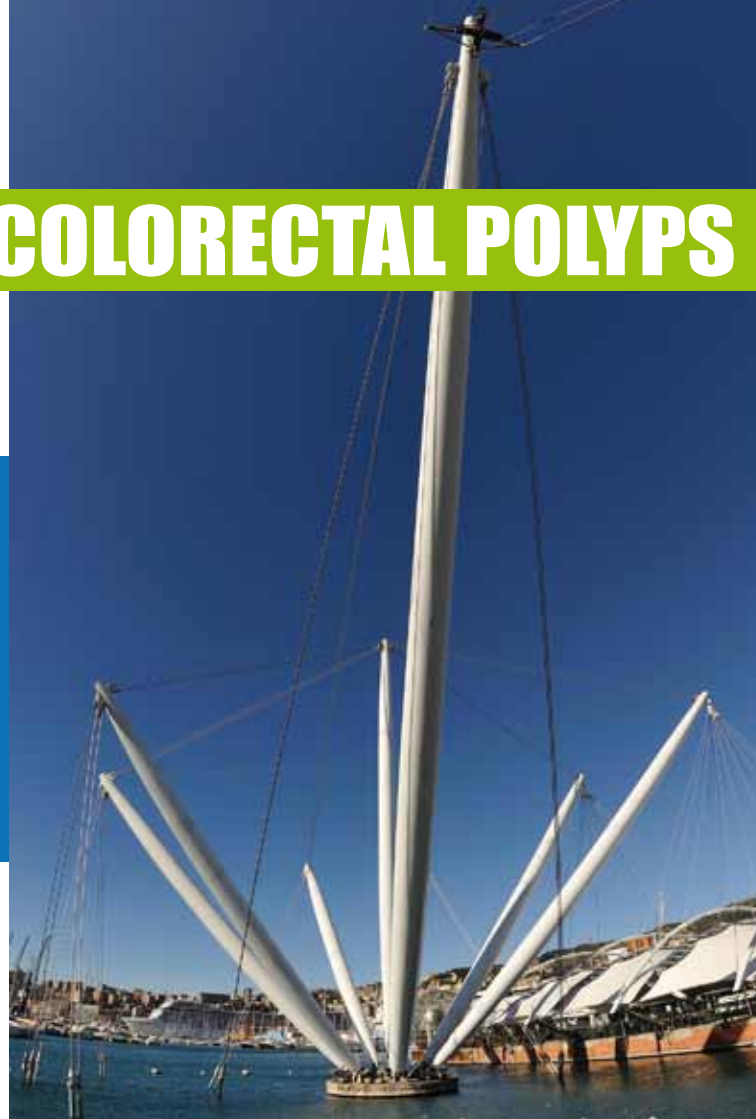
# RECENT ADVANCES IN COLORECTAL POLYPS
